Ordinance No. NC- 80, S-89

ORDINANCE

FIXING THE PER DIEM (COMMUTABLE ALLOWANCE) OF CITY COUNCILORS AT ONE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED PESOS (P1,600.00) PER REGULAR SESSION OF THE QUEZON CITY COUNCIL EFFECTIVE FEBRUARY 2, 1988, REVERTING TO THE GENERAL FUND THE AMOUNT OF TWO MILLION PESOS (P2,000,000.00) APPROPRIATED UNDER "OTHERS" ACCOUNT OF THE QUEZON CITY COUNCIL PROVIDED IN ORDINANCE NO. NC-72, S-88 (1989 ANNUAL BUDGET), RE-APPROPRIATING THE REVERTED SUM FOR THE PARTIAL FUNDING THEREOF.

WHEREAS, since February, 1988 the Quezon City Council has been religiously holding two (2) sessions a week mandated under the City Charter and the internal rules of the City Council;

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 33, S-88 of the City Council has so authorized the City Councilors to receive One Thousand Six Hundred Pesos (P1,600.00) in per diem (commutable allowance) per regular session;

WHEREAS, the Honorable Secretary of the Department of Local Government has accordingly granted exemption from the operation of Cir. No. 31 and Resolution Nos. 31 and 37 and interposed no objection thereto, provided that an ordinance to this effect is accordingly passed conformably with the provisions of the Local Government Code (BP 337);

NOW, THEREFORE,

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City in session assembled:

SECTION 1. Effective February 2, 1988 the per diem (commutable allowance) of Quezon City Councilors is hereby fixed at One Thousand Six Hundred Pesos (P1,600.00) per regular session of the City Council.

SECTION 2. The amount of Two Million Pesos (P2,000,000.00) appropriated under "Others" account of the Other Services of the Quezon City Council under Ordinance No. 72, S-88 is hereby reverted to the General Fund.

SECTION 3. The reverted sum of Two Million Pesos (P2,000,000.00) is hereby re-appropriated to cover the partial funding of the differential in per
