Be it enacted by the City Council of Quezon City in session assembled:

SECTION 1. Sections One and Two of Quezon City Ordinance No. 1685 are hereby amended by substituting the following:

"Section 1. Quezon City is hereby divided into twenty-four (24) areas (sub-cities) to be known as and composed of:
