ORDINANCE  
REQUIRING ALL BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS AND OCCUPATIONAL UNDERTAKINGS TO REGISTER AND SECURE A BUSINESS PERMIT REGISTRATION PLATE BEFORE STARTING A BUSINESS AND/OR UNDERTAKING, APPROPRIATING SIX HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P600,000.00) NECESSARY FOR THE PROPER IMPLEMENTATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City in session assembled:

SECTION 1. Definition of Terms. - "Business Permit Registration Plate" as used in this Ordinance, means an embossed tin plate designed in the same manner as that of a motor vehicle registration plate being issued by the Land Transportation Office, to show that a business operation or undertaking in Quezon City is duly registered and authorized to operate a certain kind of business/undertaking.

SECTION 2. Owners, operators or undertakers of any business establishments or undertaking with a fixed place of operation, are hereby required to register and secure a Business Permit Registration Plate after a Business Permit is secured and paid from the Business Permits and License Office, before the start of any business operation or undertaking.

SECTION 3. For purposes of insuring that all business establishments with a fixed place of business have secured and paid the required Business Permit and License before the start of a business operation and/or undertaking and the continuous payment of due taxes and fees for each year of operation, thereby eliminating illegal operations which defraud the government of due revenues and for the curtailment of delinquencies in the payment of taxes and fees, the following rules and regulations shall be observed, complied with and strictly
