ORDINANCE

ESTABLISHING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC ORDER AND SAFETY IN THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT AND PROVIDING FOR AND DEFINING ITS ORGANIZATION STRUCTURE, DUTIES, FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES.

Be it enacted by the City Council of Quezon City in session assembled:

SECTION 1. There is hereby established in the Quezon City Government the Department of Public Order and Safety whose organization structure, duties, functions and responsibilities are as provided or defined in the attached supporting documents consisting of eighteen (18) pages which are made integral parts of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. The head of the department created under Section One hereof shall have the rank and salary of a regular department head of the Quezon City Government and the salaries and emoluments of the positions created herein shall be in accordance with the provisions of Republic Act 6758 and other applicable laws, rules and regulations.

The position of the Head of the Department is hereby declared primarily confidential and co-terminus with the term of the office of the Appointing Authority, and his appointment is subject to the confirmation of the City Council.
