



Ordinance No. NC- 147, S-90

**ORDINANCE
PROHIBITING BUTCHERS (MATADEROS) FROM BRINGING
THEIR TOOLS OF TRADE OUTSIDE THEIR RESPECTIVE
PLACES OF WORK AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR
VIOLATIONS THEREOF.**

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Quezon City in session assembled:

SECTION 1. DEFINITION OF TERMS. - For purposes of this Ordinance, the following words shall have the following meanings:

- 1) **BUTCHERS (MATADEROS)** - means those workers employed by slaughter houses, markets, meatshops and other similar establishments for the purpose of butchering hogs, cattles, carabaos for commercial purposes.
- 2) **TOOLS OF TRADE** - means any sharp and/or pointed instruments, bladed knives and axes used by butchers (mataderos) in the performance of their work.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any butcher (matadero) or any other personnel of slaughter houses, markets, meatshops to bring out of their places of work their tools of trade.

SECTION 3. For purposes of this Ordinance the managers or owners of slaughter houses,
