**ORDINANCE**

**PROVIDING FOR A SITE WITHIN THE CITY HALL COMPOUND FOR THE COMELEC BUILDING AND APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF TWO MILLION PESOS (P2,000,000.00) FOR THE PURPOSE.**

WHEREAS, while every effort is being directed by the Quezon City Government toward the improvement and facility in the delivery of major and urgent services to the Quezon City residents, one area of concern which has long been neglected but which significantly affects the Quezon City residents as well, involves the security of election results and records;

WHEREAS, the dilapidated one-storey building located at the Old City Hall, Barangay Pinagkaisahan, presently being occupied by the Election Registrar's Office, is being claimed as part of the Ramon Mag-saysay High School, according to reliable information received;

WHEREAS, the present one-storey building is too small and too congested an area which cannot give sufficient room for forty (40) employees and the voluminous records under its custody. The unpleasant and deplorable working condition of the employees is very apparent. As one gets inside the office, dusty records placed in corners of the room greet him, the furnitures are too old and unrepresentable for office use, and the atmosphere is too hot and dusty
