ORDINANCE

REALIGNING AND DENOMINATING THE APPROPRIATION OF THE SUM OF EIGHT MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P8,700,000.00) UNDER CAPITAL OUTLAY (MOTOR VEHICLES - P7,500,000.00) AND (MOTORCYCLES - P1,200,000.00) OF THE PEOPLE PATROL GROUP COVERED BY ORDINANCE NO. NC-158, S-90 (1990 SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 4, GENERAL FUND) TO AND AS FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AND/OR AID TO THE QUEZON CITY POLICE STATION (DEPARTMENT), THIS CITY.

Be it enacted by the City Council of
Quezon City in session assembled:

SECTION 1. The amount of Seven Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (P7,500,000.00) for Motor Vehicles and One Million Two Hundred Thousand Pesos (P1,200,000.00) for Motorcycles, respectively, approved under the 1990 Supplemental Budget No. 4 (General Fund) covered by City Ordinance No. NC-158, S-90 under the capital outlay of the People Patrol Group, are hereby realigned to be denominated as financial assistance and/or aid to the Quezon City Police Station (Department), for the purchase of motor vehicles and motorcycles badly needed by the Quezon City Police authorities in the maintenance of public peace, order and safety.

SECTION 2. In line with the Sub-City Program of the Quezon City Government the motor vehicles and motorcycles mentioned in Section One hereof shall be assigned to the Sub-Cities.
