ORDINANCE

APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION FIFTY THOUSAND PESOS (P1,050,000.00) OUT OF ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS OF THE CITY TREASURY TO BE MADE AVAILABLE AS FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE TYPHOON VICTIMS IN THE VISAYAS AND MINDANAO RESULTING FROM FURY AND DEVASTATION CAUSED BY TYPHOON RUPING ON NOVEMBER 8, 1990.

WHEREAS, on November, 1990, a strength typhoon codenamed Ruping swept through the Visayas and Mindanao, leaving in its wake untold sufferings to the inhabitants of said area and extensive damage to properties;

WHEREAS, in order to mitigate the effects of said calamity and generate the rehabilitation of said area, the President of the Philippines had declared several provinces in the Visayas and Mindanao, which stood in the path of said typhoon, under a state of calamity, and had called on all agencies of the government and the private sector to extend assistance to the victims thereof;

WHEREAS, in the spirit of brotherhood and humanitarian concern, there is a need for Quezon City to extend financial assistance to said typhoon victims in the Visayas and Mindanao and contribute, in a manner, to the rehabilitation of said area;
