ORDINANCE

ESTABLISHING THE QUEZON CITY MORGUE, DEFINING ITS FUNCTIONS, PROVIDING FOR ITS PERSONNEL SET-UP, APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF FIVE MILLION PESOS (₱5,000,000.00) REQUIRED THEREFOR AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, considering its large and increasing population, there is an urgent need for Quezon City to have a public morgue where the bodies of unknown dead persons and of those dead of unknown causes can be kept for identification and examination before burial;

WHEREAS, at present the bodies of unknown dead persons are brought to privately-owned morgues, mortuaries and/or funeral parlors, while the bodies of those dead of unknown causes are brought to the National Bureau of Investigation, Philippine Constabulary Crime Laboratory, and/or privately-owned hospitals, the costs of which have become prohibitive;

WHEREAS, in view thereof, it is imperative for the City to establish and operate a public morgue to serve the above purpose, to ensure the dignity of the dead, protect the surviving
