ORDINANCE
AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. NC-184, S-90, EXEMPTING
THE CENTRAL POLICE DISTRICT COMMAND FROM THE
COVERAGE OF THE TWENTY PERCENT (20%) MANDATORY
RESERVED PROVIDED FOR UNDER THE CONDITIONS AND
PROVISOS OF THE 1991 ANNUAL BUDGET.

WHEREAS, under the 1991 Annual Budget
(Ordinance No. NC-184, S-90), the City Govern-
ment appropriated Thirteen Million Six Hundred
Fifty-One Thousand Pesos (P13,651,000.00) and
Fifteen Million Pesos (P15,000,000.00) for
Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses and
for Capital Outlay, respectively, as financial
assistance for the Central Police District;

WHEREAS, under the 1991 Annual Budget
(Ordinance No. NC-184, S-90) twenty percent (20%)
of appropriations for Maintenance and Other
Operating Expenses and for Capital Outlay for
all departments and offices, except the City
Council, is reserved to finance the One Hundred
Million Pesos (P100,000,000.00) appropriation for
Barangay Assistance Fund;

WHEREAS, a representation was made by Brig.
Gen. Romeo S. San Diego, District Director,
Central Police District Command, addressed to
the Hon. Vice Mayor Vicente C. Sotto, III, Presi-
ding Officer, Quezon City Council, thru the
Honorable members of the City Council, requesting
exemption of the Central Police District Command
from the coverage of the twenty percent (20%)
