CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. Barangay Bahay Toro is sub-divided
into eight (8) barangays which contain the following
boundaries:

1. BAHAY TORO I

WEST - Dario Creek to Seminary Road
NORTH - Seminary Road, Seminary Fence,
Saluysuy Creek
SOUTH - EDSA from Dario Bridge to Culi-
at Bridge
EAST - Culi- at River, Saluysuy Creek,
Seminary Fence, Seminary Road

2. BAHAY TORO II (MOTHER BARANGAY)

WEST - Dario Creek, Saluysuy Creek, Semi-
nary Road
NORTH - Dario Creek to Shorthorn St. to
Road 20
SOUTH - Culi- at River to Saluysuy Creek,
Seminary Fence
EAST - Shorthorn to Congressional Ave. to
Culi- at Bridge
