BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON
CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. That Barangay Bagbag is subdivided
into seven (7) barangays which contain the following
boundaries:

1. BAGBAG I (Mother Barangay)

NORTH - Pagkabuhay Road, Goodwill Town-
house Service Road
EAST - Quirino Hi-way
WEST - King Alexis Street, Diliman Creek;
King Christian Street, Katipunan
Avenue
SOUTH - Del Nacia Subdivision

2. BAGBAG II

NORTH - Rockville II Avenue, Olas Wall (North)
EAST - Jade Street, Bagbag Reservoir Wall
MWSS Service Road
WEST - Boundary of Remarville Subd. (West)
SOUTH - Proposed Republic Avenue
