ORDINANCE

REQUIRING ALL THEATER OWNERS/OPERATORS/LESSEES TO REMIT DIRECTLY TO THE QUEZON CITY TREASURER, ALL AMUSEMENT TAXES COLLECTED FOR THE TEN (10) DAY METRO MANILA FILM FESTIVAL FROM DECEMBER 25, 1991 TO JANUARY 3, 1992 AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the national policy of the 1987 Constitution is to ensure the autonomy of the local government units;

WHEREAS, by virtue of the promulgation of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the New Local Government Code of 1991, all general and special laws, acts, city charters, decrees, executive orders, proclamation and administrative regulations were repealed;

WHEREAS, the Movie Workers Welfare Foundation, Inc. (Mowelfund) is a private non-stock, non-profit organization, promoting the Filipino Film Festival starting December 25 to January 3 of each year;

WHEREAS, thru Presidential proclamations, MOWEL Foundation Inc. was previously granted exemptions from the 30% amusement tax and the proceeds thereof were directly remitted to the MOWEL Foundation, Inc.;

WHEREAS, under Chapter 5, Section 192 of the Code, the Local Government units may, through ordinances duly approved, grant tax exemptions, incentives or reliefs under such terms and conditions as they may deem necessary with the concurrence of at least two thirds of all its members;
