



Ordinance No. NC- 252, S-92

ORDINANCE

EXTENDING MATERIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE NOVEMBER 13 VICTIMS OF FIRE THAT BURNED THE RESIDENTIAL HOUSES OF SEVENTY EIGHT FAMILIES AT BARANGAY TATALON, AREA 21, SUB-CITY NEW MANILA, DISTRICT IV, QUEZON CITY, AT ONE THOUSAND PESOS (P1,000.00) PER FAMILY-OWNER AND FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (P500.00) PER FAMILY-RENTER, AND APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF FIFTY FIVE THOUSAND PESOS (P55,000.00), WHICH SHALL BE TAKEN FROM THE CALAMITY OR EMERGENCY FUND OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE SOURCE OF FUND THEREOF.
