WHEREAS, it is common and public knowledge  
that domestic helpers have been the victim of, and  
at times, perpetrators of numerous abuses and/or  
crimes;

WHEREAS, as can be gleaned from local news-  
paper, domestic helpers, both male and female  
have perpetrated some heinous crimes such as  
robbery with homicide, kidnapping for ransom, theft  
etc. against their employers which leave the latter,  
as well as police authorities, at a loss as to  
where to trace/apprehend the culprits to make them  
face up to their crimes;

WHEREAS, on the other hand, domestic helpers  
are likewise victims of physical as well as mental  
abuses by their employers, such as non-payment of  
wages, infliction of physical harm, sexual harrass-  
ment, mental torture, etc., and being comparatively  
newly settled in the metropolis, financially dis-  
advantaged and without any close relative to turn  
to for financial and/or moral support are likewise  
at a loss as to whom to turn to in time of their  
dire need;

WHEREAS, by calling for the registration of  
all domestic helpers with the barangay, employers  
would at least have a record of their helper to  
fall back to in case of need for same, while domes-  
tic helpers will likewise have a record of their
