

RESOLUTION NO. SP-_____, S-2019

A RESOLUTION APPEALING TO ALL CINEMA OPERATORS IN QUEZON CITY TO EXTEND AN ADDITIONAL ONE (1) DAY FREE ADMISSION TO ALL REGISTERED SENIOR CITIZENS OF THE CITY ASIDE FROM THE EXISTING PRIVILEGE GRANTED DURING MONDAY AND TUESDAY.

Introduced by Councilor JORGE L. BANAL.

WHEREAS, Senior citizens constitute a marginalized sector of the society that plays a vital role in the progress of the city;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Council adopted Resolution No. SP-3249, S-2006 and Resolution No. SP-4629, S-2009, both measures “urged all Cinema Operators in Quezon City to grant Free Admission to all Senior Citizens of the City”;

WHEREAS, after a series of dialogue, cinema operators acceded to the request by granting free admission to Senior Citizens of Quezon City every Monday and Tuesday;


WHEREAS, it is a common knowledge that Senior Citizens increases its number annually, as such, it has been observed that inconvenience is created not only to the Senior Citizens but also to the cinema operators and their paying clients during the days when Senior citizens avail of the free cinema admission.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to appeal, as it does hereby appeal to all cinema operators in Quezon City to extend an additional One (1) day free admission to all registered Senior Citizens of the City aside from the existing privilege granted during Monday and Tuesday.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that copy of this Resolution be furnished to all cinema operators in Quezon City for their information.
