PROPOSED RESOLUTION NO. _____, S-2019

A RESOLUTION REQUIRING BUSINESSES, EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS, AND HEALTH CARE FACILITIES TO SUBMIT THEIR DRRM PLANS, CONTINGENCY, EMERGENCY PLANS AND OTHER RELATED PLANS TO THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT FOR INTEGRATION INTO THE CITY'S PLANS FOR DRRM.

Introduced by Councilor Hero M. Bautista

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No. 7160 expressly states that "Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied there from, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental of its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare,"

WHEREAS, Section 12 of Republic Act No. 10121 states that Local Disaster Risk Reduction Management Office shall facilitate and support risk assessments and contingency planning activities at the local level.

WHEREAS, the Quezon City Government envisions an integrated Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (DRRM) System that fosters a sustainable, safe, and resilient Quezon City. In view of this, the Quezon City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (QCDRRMC) intend to review and realign the DRRM and contingency plans at all levels according to the national and local standards and guidelines;

WHEREAS, the formulation and implementation of the Quezon City Contingency Plan for Flood, Earthquake as well as the DRRM Plan are anchored on the scientific knowledge and deep understanding of the city hazards, vulnerability, and risk to human induced or natural disaster or calamities, and has undertaken a collaborative and comprehensive planning process with the help of Earthquake Megacities Initiative (EMI);

WHEREAS, the declared policy of Quezon City Government that shall adopt measures to protect the inhabitants of the city from harmful effects of man-made or natural disaster and calamities, and to provide coordinated relief services and assistance for victims during and in the aftermath of said disaster or calamities;

WHEREAS, the QCDRRMO, through the guidance of the Office of Civil Defense, shall issue Department of Building Official standard templates for emergency/evacuation plans for establishments to use as basis in crafting their own plan;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED to require Businesses, Educational Institutions, and Health Care Facilities to submit their DRRM Plans, Contingency, Emergency Plans, and Other Related Plans to the Quezon City Government for Integration into the City's Plans for DRRM;

Resolved, further that copy of the resolution shall be forwarded to the City Mayor and other concerned offices and/or department for their information and appropriate action.
