PROPOSED RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING QUEZON CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE MA. JOSEFINA G. BELMONTE, TO EXTEND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE OF TEN THOUSAND PESOS (PHP 10,000.00) TO EACH OF THE REMAINING (51) INFORMAL SETTLERS FAMILIES (ISFs) WHOs ARE STILL OCCUPYING CONSTRUCTION SITES OF THE REMAINING BUILDINGS OF BISTEKVILLE-15 HOUSING PROJECT, LOCATED IN BARANGAY SAUYO, QUEZON CITY, EQUIVALENT TO A TOTAL AMOUNT OF FIVE HUNDRED TEN THOUSAND PESOS (PHP 510,000.00).

WHEREAS, based on the census tagging and validation which was earlier conducted by the National Housing Authority (NHA) at the project site of Bistekville – 15 Housing Project, one hundred eight (180) informal settler families (ISFs) were verified occupying the area, which validation was conducted in relation to ISFs request for off city relocation;

WHEREAS, sixty six (66) of the aforesaid number of ISFs had been relocated to NHA off-city resettlement site, forty two (42) were awarded condominium units as on-site beneficiaries of the project, others opted to just receive financial assistance, while the remaining fifty one (51) ISFs, whose structures are now occupying the construction sites of the remaining buildings of the project, had requested for on-site relocation,

WHEREAS, the above-cited request of the remaining on-site ISFs was favorably considered by the previous Task Force on Socialized Housing and Development of Blighted Areas (TF Housing), and as such, said ISFs have to wait for their allocated units to be constructed and completed;

WHEREAS, to draw cooperation from the affected ISFs to voluntarily dismantle their respective structures and also to provide them fund for their immediate need of electricity and water supply connections, there is a need for the Quezon City Government to allocate and extend financial assistance of Php 10,000.00 to each of the 51 affected ISFs in the total amount of Php 510,000.00;


WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 455 (b) (1) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991", the City Mayor shall represent the City in all its transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts and obligations, and such other documents upon the authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinance

NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT RRESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it does hereby authorize, the City Mayor of Quezon City, Honorable Ma. Josefina G. Belmonte, to extend financial assistance of Ten Thousand Pesos (Php 10,000.00) to each pf the remaining (51) informal settler families (ISFs), who are still occupying construction sites of the remaining building of Bistekville-15 Housing Project, located in Barangay Sauyo, Quezon City, equivalent to a total amount of Five Hundred Ten Thousand Pesos (Php 510,000.00).
