PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_, S-2016

**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2017 IN THE AMOUNT OF SEVENTEEN BILLION SEVEN HUNDRED TWENTY MILLION PESOS (P17,720,000,000.00) COVERING THE VARIOUS EXPENDITURES FOR THE OPERATION OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY FUND FOR THE PURPOSE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Local Chief Executive submitted to the Sanguniang Panglungsod, through the Office of the City Secretary, the proposed budget of the city on October 18, 2016;

**WHEREAS**, the Local Government Code provides that "on or before the end of the current fiscal year, the Sangguniang concerned shall enact through an ordinance, the annual budget of the local government unit for the ensuing fiscal year on the basis of the estimates of income and expenditures";

**WHEREAS**, there is an urgent need to pass this ordinance to support the financial needs and expenditures of the City Government for the year 2017;

**NOW THEREFORE,  
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION  
ASSEMBLED:**

**SECTION 1.** The Annual Budget of the Quezon City Government for the Calendar Year 2017 is hereby approved in the amount of Seventeen Billion Seven Hundred Twenty Million Pcsos (P17,720,000,000.00) covering the various expenditures for the operation of the City Government;

The budget documents consisting of the following are incorporated herein and made an integral part of this Ordinance:

1. Budget Message of the City Mayor, Honorable Herbert M. Bautista;
2. Statement of receipts;
3. Statement of receipts and expenditures;
4. Consolidated program appropriation and obligation by object of expenditures;
5. Statement of statutory and contractual obligation and budgetary requirements;
6. Statement of fund operation;
7. Personnel schedule.

**SECTION 2.** There is hereby appropriated by the general fund the sum of Seventeen Billion Seven Hundred Twenty Million Pesos (P17,720,000,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to be taken from the estimate of revenue certified as available for appropriation by the City Treasurer as contained in the budget documents;

**SECTION 3. SEPARABILITY.** If, for any reason, any section or provision of this ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, other sections, part of provisions hereof which are not affected shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY.** This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
