PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. _____ -S-2018

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE OF FIVE HUNDRED PESOS (PHP500.00) EACH TO NATIONAL PAID PERMANENT TEACHING AND NON TEACHING PERSONNEL OF THE SCHOOLS DIVISION OFFICE IN QUEZON CITY, AS PART OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT'S PAMASKONG HANDOG 2018, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFORE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the 1987 Constitution recognizes the importance of education in the achievement of national growth as it assigns the highest budgetary priority and ensure that teaching will attract and retain its rightful share of the best available talents through adequate remuneration and other means of job satisfaction and fulfillment;

WHEREAS, Section 17 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, authorizes local government units to provide adequate support to efficient and effective provision of basic services such as education;

WHEREAS, under Section 458 (a) (1) (viii) of Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 empowers the Sangguniang Panlungsod to "determine the positions and the salaries, wages, allowances and other emoluments and benefits of officials and employees paid wholly or mainly from city funds and provide for expenditures necessary for the proper conduct of programs, projects, services, and activities of the city government";

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Local Government of Quezon City to promote and improve the social and economic status of its public school teaching and non-teaching personnel;

WHEREAS, this Ordinance aims to assist our public school personnel and recognize their immense contribution to society as they nurture the future leaders of our country.

NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. PROVISION OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE - National paid permanent teaching and non-teaching personnel of the Schools Division Office in Quezon City shall hereby be provided with a financial assistance as Pamaskong Handog of Five Hundred Pesos (Php500.00).

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - Such amount as may be necessary for the implementation of this Ordinance is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the City.


SECTION 3. REPEALING CLAUSE - All ordinances, executive orders and administrative regulations or parts thereof which are inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed and/or modified accordingly.

SECTION 4. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE - If for any reason, any section or provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, other parts or provision thereof which are not affected shall continue to remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY - Upon its approval, this Ordinance shall take effect December 2018.
