PROPOSED RESOLUTION NO. SP____; Series of 2017

"A RESOLUTION RATIFYING THE "DEED OF DONATION" ENTERED INTO AND SIGNED BY THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT (QCG) THROUGH MAYOR HERBERT M BAUTISTA, FOR THE FORTY SIX (46) UNITS OF AMBULANCE, TO BE DONATED AND UTILIZED BY THE VARIOUS BARANGAYS OF QUEZON CITY AND THE QUEZON CITY DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT OFFICE (QCDRRMO), SUBJECT TO EXISTING LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS."

WHEREAS, under the Local Government Code of 1991 specifically, section 17. Basic Services and Facilities:

(a) Local government units shall endeavor to be self-reliant and shall continue exercising the powers and discharging the duties and functions currently vested upon them. They shall also discharge the functions and responsibilities of national agencies and offices devolved to them pursuant to this Code. Local government units shall likewise exercise such other powers and discharge such other functions and responsibilities as are necessary, appropriate, or incidental to efficient and effective provisions of the basic services and facilities enumerated herein"

WHEREAS, the City Government is empowered under Section 447 (1), (IV) of RA7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, to "Adopt measures to protect the inhabitants of the municipality from the harmful effects of man-made or natural disasters and calamities and to provide relief services and assistance for victims during and in the aftermath of said disasters or calamities and their return to productive livelihood following said events";

WHEREAS, the various Barangays of Quezon City and the QC Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (QCDRRMO) share a common objective: "to provide quality service which will make Quezon City an ideal community where people live, work and do business in a hospitable, progressive and peaceful environment";

WHEREAS, the donation of the Forty Six (46) units of ambulance and its accessories are necessary to provide immediate assistance as well as to inspire and further show the Quezon City Government's support various Barangays of Quezon City and the QC Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (QCDRRMO);

WHEREAS, as a sign of sincere token of the Quezon City Government through Mayor Herbert M Bautista's support to the Barangays of Quezon City to their respective jurisdiction and the QC Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (QCDRRMO)'s to attain their mandated function.


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED: TO RATIFY, AS IT HEREBY RATIFIES, the "DEED OF DONATION" ENTERED INTO AND SIGNED BY THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT (QCG) through MAYOR HERBERT M BAUTISTA, FOR THE FORTY SIX (46) UNITS OF AMBULANCE, TO BE DONATED AND UTILIZED BY THE VARIOUS BARANGAYS OF QUEZON CITY AND THE QUEZON CITY DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT OFFICE (QCDRRMO), SUBJECT TO EXISTING LAWS, RULES AND REGULATIONS."

This Deed of Donation made and executed by and between:

The **QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT**, a public corporation created pursuant to CA502, as amended, and RA7160, as amended, with office address at Quezon City Hall, Elliptical Road, Barangay Central, Quezon City represented herein by **MAYOR HERBERT M BAUTISTA**, hereinafter referred to as the "**Donor**";

Witnesseth, that:

WHEREAS, the City Government is empowered under Section 447 (1), (IV) of RA7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, to "Adopt measures to protect the inhabitants of the municipality from the harmful effects of man-made or natural disasters and calamities and to provide relief services and assistance for victims during and in the aftermath of said disasters or calamities and their return to productive livelihood following said events";

WHEREAS, Quezon City Government (QCG) mandates "the promotion and development of an earthquake risk reduction and management program, in order to mitigate if not to eliminate the effects of a major natural and man-made disasters as well as to protect the health, safety and general welfare especially the Quezon City residents";

WHEREAS, herein **DONOR**, The **QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT** represented by **MAYOR HERBERT M BAUTISTA**, is the absolute and legal owner and by way of procurement of the Forty Six (46) units of ambulance with accessories, herein subject of this **DEED OF DONATION**;

I ACCEPTANCE OF THE DONEE

The **DONEE** hereby receives and accepts the donation and hereby expresses its appreciation to the **DONOR** for its acts of generosity.

The **DONEE** hereby undertakes to maintain the subject of donation in good condition and to be use specifically to serve its purpose, for and in behalf of its constituents.

II STIPULATION OF THE QCG, VARIOUS BARANGAYS and the QCRRMO

The Forty Six (46) units of ambulance with accessories (*herein subject of this Deed of Donation*) shall be issued **ONLY** for the utilization of the **VARIOUS BARANGAYS and the QCRRMO** members/ personnel/ staff assigned to the **QCRRMO** and the **Barangays** and those who shall be transferred/reassigned and/or their services have ended must surrender/turn over the *herein subject of this Deed of Donation* to the Supply Officer of the **QCRRMO**, as well as for the staff and personnel of the **Barangays** concerned, to return the said Ambulance with Accesories to their respective Barangay Custodian.

Finally, Renewal of Registration for the Forty Six (46) units of ambulance with accessories shall likewise be facilitated and fees to be paid by the **VARIOUS BARANGAYS** and the **QCRRMO**.
