## PROPOSED RESOLUTION NO. \_\_\_\_\_

A RESOLUTION STRONGLY SUPPORTING HOUSE BILL NO. 7211, ENTITLED, "AN ACT INCREASING THE MINIMUM SALARIES OF PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHERS AND OTHER GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES AND AUGMENTING THE PERSONNEL ECONOMIC RELIEF ALLOWANCE

WHEREAS, the 1987 Constitution recognizes the importance of education in the attainment of national growth as it assigns to it the highest budgetary priority, and ensures that teaching will attract and retain its rightful share of the best available talents through adequate remuneration and other means of job satisfaction and fulfillment;

WHEREAS, House Bill No. 7211 aims to raise the salary of a regular entry-level position in government services to not less than Php16,000 monthly and increase the present entry-level salary of public school teachers and teaching personnel in State and Local Universities and Colleges to not less than Php30,000 and Php31,000 respectively;

**WHEREAS**, House Bill No. 7211 likewise proposes to increase the Personnel Economic Relief Allowance (PERA) to Php 5,000 per month;

WHEREAS, this Resolution supports House Bill No. 7211 in order to assist our public school teachers and recognize their immense contribution to society as they nurture the future leaders of our country.

## NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to support, as it does hereby strongly support, House Bill No. 7211, entitled "An Act Increasing the Minimum Salaries of Public School Teachers and Other Government Employees and Augmenting the Personnel Economic Relief Allowance."
