A RESOLUTION STRONGLY URGING HONORABLE CITY MAYOR HERBERT CONSTANTINE M. BAUTISTA, QUEZON CITY TO PROVIDE FUNDS FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF AN INTEGRATED BARANGAY INFORMATION SYSTEM (IBIS) IN 142 BARANGAYS OF QUEZON CITY.

Introduced by COUNCILORS HERO CLARENCE M. BAUTISTA, GIAN CARLO G. SOTTO, ALEXIS R. HERRERA, DONATO C. MATIAS and ALFREDO S. ROXAS

WHEREAS, Integrated Barangay Information System (IBIS), is a web based and enterprise system with professional technical services to the city's 142 barangays to be centrally deployed to the city's Data Center for linkage to the city offices, DRRMD and Quezon City Police Department (QCPD) Data Center and for their respective transactions pertaining to barangay matters;

WHEREAS, IBIS is featured to have a uniformed standardized system modules namely; Barangay Profile, Barangay Resident Registry, Face Recognition System, Barangay Business Clearances Issuances, Barangay Judicial System, Barangay Disaster Risk Reduction Management and Executive Dashboard; and is designed to create a Unified Identification (ID) System in Quezon City to effectively enforce Peace and Order, to efficiently address Basic Services and to ensure conformity with the Ease with Doing Business Law;

WHEREAS, IBIS is a compliance to the Information Systems Strategic Plan (ISSP) 2018-2020 launched by the Department of Information and Communications Technology (DICT) whose primary purpose is to present an overall strategic plan for the development and implementation of Information Systems and the use of Information and Communication Technology (ICT) as a tool to ensure its application in the strategic areas of government concern, as well as in the barangay level;


WHEREAS, IBIS is no less than endorsed by the Office of the Liga ng Barangay together with barangay captains in all districts of our city, the Office of Quezon City Police Department (QCPD) presently headed by Senior Superintendent Joselito Esquivel; and its former director and now chief of National Capital Region Police Office (NCRPO) Chief Superintendent Guillermo Eleazar, and a response to the present National Government call to promote and develop plans and actions to make basic services more closer and reachable, to swiftly expedite business transactions, and to eradicate red tapes in the service for the people.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED to urge as it does hereby strongly urged Honorable City Mayor Herbert Constantine M.
