A RESOLUTION AMENDING CITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO. SP-7300, S-2017 ENTITLED, "A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, QUEZON CITY, TO EXTEND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE OF FIVE THOUSAND PESOS (PHP 5,000.00) TO EACH OF THE TWO THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED SIX (2,706) INFORMAL SETTLER FAMILIES (ISFs) WHO WILL BE AFFECTED BY THE PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS (DPWH) RETARDING POND AND HOUSING PROJECT TO BE BUILT BY LGU-QC ON TOP OF SAID POND, LOCATED IN KAINGIN BUKID, BARANGAY APOLONIO SAMSON, QUEZON CITY, AND WHO ARE ABOUT TO BE TEMPORARILY RELOCATED TO NATIONAL HOUSING AUTHORITY (NHA) RESETTLEMENT SITES, SO AS TO GIVE WAY TO THE IMPLEMENTATION OF SAID PROJECTS, EQUIVALENT TO A TOTAL AMOUNT OF THIRTEEN MILLION FIVE HUNDRED THIRTY THOUSAND PESOS (PHP 13,530,000.00)", ADJUSTING THE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO BE EXTENDED TO EACH QUALIFIED ISFS TO BE AFFECTED BY THE CONSTRUCTION OF A RETARDING POND ALONG SAN FRANCISCO RIVER IN KAINGIN BUKID, BGY. APOLONIO SAMSON, QUEZON CITY, FROM PHP 5,000.00 TO PHP 18,000.00.

WHEREAS, the partnership between the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) and Quezon City Government (LGU-QC) for the construction of a flood mitigation project (Retarding Pond) along the easement of San Francisco River in Kaingin Bukid, Bgy. Apolonio Samson, and a socialized housing project on top of the pond, primarily requires the clearing of the project site, a 12 low-lying parcels of land with a gross area of more or less 24,603 square meters, from informal settler structures and other obstructions;

WHEREAS, to implement the clearing of the project site and relocation of affected ISFs, DPWH and LGU-QC have agreed to provide financial assistance of Php 18,000.00 per qualified ISFs, the same amount being extended by the national government to ISFs along waterways. DPWH for its part has incorporated to its project cost a financial assistance package of Thirty Million Pesos (Php 30,000,000.00) while LGU-QC, as approved by the Quezon City Council Resolution No. SP-7300, S-2017, has allocated a financial assistance fund of Thirteen Million Five Hundred Thirty Thousand Pesos (Php 13,530,000.00). As committed, said financial assistance fund of DPWH will be downloaded to LGU-QC by the end of February 2019;

WHEREAS, inasmuch as DPWH has commenced the construction of the Retarding Pond along the 10.0 meter easement of San Francisco River, with NHA providing the relocation of the more or less 200 affected on-site ISFs, there is a need to utilize the financial assistance allocation from LGU-QC as seed money to extend financial assistance of Php 18,000.00 to each of the qualified affected on-site ISF along said 10.0 meter easement;


WHEREAS, the legislative measure would amend City Council Resolution No. SP-7300, S-2017, by increasing the financial assistance of each qualified project-affected ISFs from Php 5,000.00 to Php 18,000.00;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE 20TH CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to amend, as it does hereby amend, City Council Resolution No. SP-7300, S-2017, adjusting the financial assistance of each qualified ISFs to be affected by the construction of a flood mitigation project of the DPWH, a Retarding Pond along San Francisco River in Kaingin Bukid, Barangay Apolonio Samson, Quezon City, from Php 5,000.00 to Php 18,000.00.
