PROPOSED RESOLUTION NO. _____ 2019

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT (QCG) THROUGH MAYOR HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO ENTER INTO A DEED OF DONATION IN FAVOR OF QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT FOR THE DONATION OF FIVE HUNDRED (500) UNITS OF E-TRIKES UNDER THE "E-TRIKE PROJECT" OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY (DOE) PRIMARILY TO PROMOTE ENERGY EFFECIENCY AND CLEAN TECHNOLOGIES IN THE TRANSPORT SECTOR AND TO AUGMENT LIVELIHOOD PROJECT OF THE CITY.

WHEREAS, Section 36 of R.A. 8749; otherwise known as the "Philippine Clean Air Act of 1999", states that local government units (LGUs) shall share the responsibility in the management and maintenance of air quality within their territorial jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, Section 5 (b) of the Philippine Clean Air Act of 1999, define Air pollution as any alteration of the physical, chemical and biological properties of the atmosperic air, or any discharge thereto of any liquid, gaseous or solid substances that will or is likely to create or to render the air resources of the country harmful, detrimental, or injurious to public health, safety or welfare or which will adversely affect their utilization for domestic, commercial, industrial, agricultural, recreational, or other legitimate purposes;

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the city and the welfare of its constituents to make a cleaner, greener, safer and economical way by patronizing eco-friendly vehicles;

WHEREAS, the Quezon City government fully supports the national government, through the Department of Energy (DOE), E-Trike Project to promote energy efficiency and clean technologies in the transport sector;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Quezon City recognizes the need to control and effectively manage the air pollution in the city of Quezon through programs designed to lessen or regulate emission of harmful gases into the atmosphere from motor vehicles;

WHEREAS, as per DOE data, there are five (5) million tricycles in the country that emit close to Ten (10) Million tons of harmful gases and use several Billion of US dollar worth of oil each year;

WHEREAS, a financial, social, and environmental feasibility of the conversion from existing fossil fuel engine tricycles into Electric Tricycles is supported and confirmed by the analysis on the collected data such as operation records and income/expense records of Electric Tricycle business.

WHEREAS, a sustainable business model of Electric Tricycle and the future promotion plan are developed by public and private stakeholders in the Philippines.


WHEREAS, a more holistic program or approach is needed; in order to insulate the country from high oil prices and from the harmful effect of gases emitted by tricycles is to implement long term solutions that ensure energy efficiency and sustainability for us and of future generation, is through e-trike project.

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE QUEZON CITY COUNCIL SESSION ASSEMBLED; to authorize as it hereby the Quezon City government (QCG) through mayor Herbert M. Bautista, to enter into a deed of donation in favor of Quezon City government for the donation of five hundred (500) units of e-trikes under the "E-Trike project" of the Department Of Energy (DOE) primarily to promote energy efficiency and clean technologies in the transport sector and to augment livelihood project of the city.
