WHEREAS, originated in Thailand, Muay Thai is a combat sport that uses stand-up striking along with various clinching techniques. It was called “the art of eight limbs” because it uses fists, elbows, knees and shins;

WHEREAS, Muay Thai became popularly known internationally in the 20th century including the Philippines. In the recently concluded 3rd Muay Thai National Finals held on November 15-20, 2018 at the PSC Sports Complex, the biggest Muay Thai event in the country, more than 300 athletes competed representing their respective local government units;

WHEREAS, Team Quezon City fielded twenty-four (24) Muay Thai athletes in the competition which serves a scouting ground for the national team and twenty-one took home a medal each. Quezon City won six golds, ten silvers and five bronzes;

WHEREAS, the impressive performance of Team Quezon City will be in the running for a spot in the Philippine National Muay Thai team;

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper for the Quezon City government to recognize and commend the hard work and determination of Quezon City Muay Thai athletes who brought honor to the City in the recently concluded 2018 Muay Thai National Finals.


