**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR, HONORABLE HERBERT M. BAUTISTA, TO EXTEND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE IN BEHALF OF THE QUEZON CITY GOVERNMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION PESOS (PHP 1,000,000) TO FUND THE PROJECTS AND ACTIVITIES OF THE FOUNDATION FOR RETIRES QUEZON CITY PRIDE, INC., TO BE TAKEN FROM THE APPROPRIATION OF GRANTS, AID AND SUBSIDIES UNDER THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR IN THE 2016 ANNUAL BUDGET OF QUEZON CITY OR FROM ANY AVAILABLE FUNDS.**

**WHEREAS**, a manifesto entitled "A Call to Unity" was circulated which launched a signature campaign calling for the unification of the two Quezon City Police Retirees Association existed at the time.

**WHEREAS**, One Hundred Eighteen police retirees coming from both organizations affixed their signatures which signified eagerness of the majority of the police retirees to have a unified association.

**WHEREAS**, after all the votes were casted and tallied, the winning candidates were declared and became the officers of the new association to be known from then on as the FOUNDATION FOR RETIRED QUEZON CITY'S PRIDE with the foundation's mission and vision embodied in their motto: Charity, Assistance, Respect and Equality (C.A.R.E.) for the retired Quezon City Policemen.

**WHEREAS**, the Quezon City Government recognizes the heroic act of these retired police officers who fulfilled their sworn duties and responsibilities without fear until their retirement.

**WHEREAS**, since its organization in 2005, the foundation had give Two Hundred Nineteen Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php 219,500.00) financial assistance to its forty three (43) ailing members and Three Hundred Ninety Five Thousand Pesos (Php 395,000.00) funeral assistance to the bereaved families of its Sixty Three (63) departed members.

**WHEREAS**, still aware of their social responsibility despite of their retirement, the foundation unanimously decided to donate One Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php 100,000.00) in cash to the victims of Typhoon Yolanda in the province of Leyte in 2013 in addition to the used clothes and food stuffs.

**WHEREAS**, in its effort to brighten the outlook of its members, some of whom are already in the twilight of their lives, the foundation made Christmas Party for its members as part of its annual tradition wherein each member receives a Christmas Package worth One Thousand Pesos (Php 1,000.00) in addition to raffle prizes.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESORVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY in the REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, to authorize, as it hereby authorize the City Mayor Honorable Herbert M. Bautista to grant financial assistance in the amount of **One Million Pesos (Php 1,000,000.00)** to **FOUNDATION FOR RETIRED QUEZON CITY, INC.**, to be taken from the appropriations for grants, aids and subsidies under the Office of the City Mayor in the 2016 Annual Budget of Quezon City or from any available funds.
