WHEREAS, malnutrition has become prevalent in the Philippines and claiming thousands of lives of children;

problem in the country urgently needs greater involvement and participation of mutritionists to serve directly those in the grassroot level;

whereas, to alleviate this problem, Presidential Decree No. 1569 entitled "Strengthening the barangay Mutrition Program by Providing for a Barangay Mutrition Scholar in every Barangay" was signed into law on June 11, 1978;

envisioned under PD 1569, the quezon ty Barangay Nutrition Scholars was constituted by the quezon City Government, to be primarily responsible for delivering nutrition services and other related activities such as community health, backyard food production, environmental sanitation, natal feeding and family planning in different Barangays most especially in the depressed areas;

WHEREAS, at present, the QCBNS is receiving daily a monthly commutable allowance at the rate of Four Hundred Pesos (P400.00) without any other emolument;

WHEREAS, this amount is inadequate taking into consideration the task the nutrition scholars have to perform, the cost of commodities at present and the fate of transportation expenses which is indispensable to their work;

WHYREAS, COMS to be more effective and inspired in extending the basic services to the constituents of this premier City, needs an increase in their monthly commutable allowance;

NOW THE PURE

Be it ordained by the City Council of wesen City in session assembled:

Section 1. The menthly commutable allowance of the Quezon City Barangay Nutrition Scholars (QCEMS) is hereby increased from Four Hundred Pesos (P400.00) to Six Hundred Pesos (P600.00). The names of the said barangay mutrition scholars shall be provided each councilor.

Section 2. The amount of Two Hundred Sixty-Four Thousand Pesos (P264,000,00) is hereby appropriated from any available funds of the City Treasury to cover the increase from January 1, 1989 to December 31, 1989.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
