ORDINANCE
INCREASING THE LONGEVITY PAY OF QUEZON CITY OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES FROM TEN PESOS (P10.00) TO FIFTY PESOS (P50.00) FOR EVERY FIVE YEARS OF CONTINUOUS SERVICE EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1989; AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY FUNDS THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Quezon City Government to uplift the standard of living and improve the quality of life of its officials and employees;

WHEREAS, due to rising cost of living, there is a need to augment the income of the Quezon City Hall Government Officials and employees;

NOW, THEREFORE,

Be it ordained by the City Council of Quezon City in session assembled:


SECTION 1. The longevity pay of Quezon City Officials and employees is hereby increased from Ten Pesos (P10.00) to Fifty Pesos (P50.00) for every five (5) years of continuous service.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall cover the officials and employees of Quezon City Government who have rendered at least five (5) years continuous service, exclusive of services rendered outside of Quezon City, with services of over ten (10) years allowing only a gap or break of less than one (1) year on account of medical and sabbatical reasons and grave family problems, to be considered as continuous.

SECTION 3. The amount of Six Million Eighty-Eight Thousand Five Hundred Fifty-Four Pesos (P6,888,554.00) is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the City Treasury to cover the payment of longevity pay provided for in Section One (1) hereof covering the period of July 1, 1989 to December 31, 1990.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect as of July 1, 1989.
