INCREASING THE LONGEVITY PAY OF QUEZON CITY OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES FROM TEN PESOS (P10.00)
TO FIFTY PESOS (P50.00) FOR EVERY FIVE YEARS OF
CONTINUOUS SERVICE EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1989; AND
APPROFRIATING THE NECESSARY FUNDS THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Queson Gity Government to uplift the standard of living and improve the quality of life of its officials and employees

WHEREAS, due to rising cost of living, there is a need to augment the income of the Quezon City Hall Government Officials and employees;

NOW, THEREFORE,

Be it ordained by the City Council of Queson City in session assembled:

SECTION 1. The longevity pay of Queson City Officials and employees is hereby increased from Ten Peses (P10.00) to Fifty Peses (P50.00) for every five (5) years of continuous service.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall cover the efficials and employees of Queson City Government who have rendered at least five (5) years continuous service, exclusive of services rendered outside of Queson City, with services of over ten (10) years allowing only a gap or break of less than one (1) year on account of medical and sabbatical reasons and grave family problems, to sabbatical reasons and grave family problems, to be considered as continuous.

SECTION 3. The amount of Six Million Eighty-Eight Thousand Five Hundred Fifty-Four Pesos (P6,088,554.00) is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the City Treasury to cover the payment of longevity pay previded for in Section One (1) hereof covering the period of July 1, 1989 to December 31, 1990.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect as of July 1, 1989.
