ORDINANCE NO. SP-351 S-95

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 5 OF ORDINANCE NO. SP-15, S-92, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. SP-292, S-92.

Introduced by Councilors BAYANI V. HIPOL, JOSEPH PETER S. SISON, CONNIE S. ANGELES, JORGE L. BANAL, CESAR A. DARIO, JR. and MOISES S. SAMSON.

WHEREAS, as presently constituted, membership in the Quezon City Tricycle Franchising Board is trisectoral as it is composed of three (3) representatives from the City Council, one (1) representative from the TODA's of each of the four (4) Districts of Quezon City, and the Head of the Tricycle Regulatory Unit:

WHEREAS, in the conduct of its functions the Board requires the presence of any four (4) of its members to constitute a quorum without specifying which sector is being represented by such present members as spelled out in Section A of Ordinance No. SP-15, S-92, as amended by Ordinance No. SP-292, S-95;

WHEREAS, in the absence of any specification as to what sector must be present in determining the existence of a quorum, a situation may arise where the Board may find itself officially functioning with only the four (4) TODA representatives in attendance, thereby depriving representation of the City Council which is the sole repository of authority in the regulation of tricycle operation in Quezon City:

WHEREAS, to correct the foregoing predicament, there is an imperative need to require that the City Council must always be represented in all official sessions conducted by the Board.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY
IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. Sec. 5 of Ordinance No. SP-15, S-92,
as amended, is hereby further amended to read as
follows:




"Section 5. The Quezon City Tricycle
Franchising Board under the Sangguniang Panlungsod
is hereby created to be composed of the following:

1. The Chairman of the Committee on
Transportation and Communication as
Chairman
2. The Vice Chairman of the Committee on
Transportation and Communication - Member
3. The Chairman of the Committee on Ways and
Means - Member
4. The Chairman of the Committee on Bgy.
Affairs and Community Relations - Member
5. The Chairman of the Committee on People's
Participation - Member
6. The Federation District Representative of
the concerned District Tricycle Operators
and Drivers Association - Member
7. The Chief of the Tricycle Regulation
Unit - Member

Section 5-A. Sessions. The Board shall meet
in regular session once a week. A special session
may be convened anytime upon request of any of its
members, but not to exceed four (4) times a month.
A quorum for any session of the Board shall consist
of a majority of the members thereof, the chairman
or any two of the councilor-members being present
therein, and a majority of such quorum shall decide
any question at the session.

The four (4) TODA representative-members
shall be entitled to an honorarium of Five Hundred
Pesos (P500.00) each per session attended.

Section 5-B. Staff Requirement. To carry on,
man and execute the day-to-day administrative
functions of the Board, the following support staff
is hereby created:



SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.


