ORDINANCE NO. SP-430, S-96

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING AND UPDATING THE NUMBERING SYSTEM FOR ALL REAL PROPERTY SITUATED WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF QUEZON CITY.

WHEREAS, the population of Quezon City has increased by leaps and bounds since a numbering system for residential, commercial, and other buildings was last implemented;

WHEREAS, consistent with this rise in population, development of housing projects as well as commercial and industrial development have also rendered the numbering system for residential, commercial, and other buildings ineffective;

WHEREAS, the delivery of mail and other basic services are hampered by the difficulty of locating residential, commercial and other building addresses;

WHEREAS, the need to update the numbering system for residential, commercial and other buildings is in line with the mandate to regulate the same pursuant to Section 458, paragraph 2(xiv) in relation to Section 16 of R.A. 7160, the Local Government Code of 1991.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. Title. This Ordinance shall be known as "The Numbering System for all real property situated within the territorial jurisdiction of Quezon City".

SECTION 2. Coverage. This Ordinance shall apply to all real property situated within the territorial jurisdiction of Quezon City.

SECTION 3. The Office of the City Engineer shall be tasked to device and implement the numbering system for all real property and assign a number for every real property situated in Quezon City.

SECTION 4. A Special Task Force is hereby created which will be composed of the representatives from the Office of the City Engineer, City Planning and Development Office, Office of the City Assessor, Office of the City Treasurer and the City Council, that will undertake the necessary study and research on the effective implementation of the provisions of this Ordinance and consequently to formulate the implementing guidelines therefor.

SECTION 5. Effectivity. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
