ORDINANCE NO. SP- 6 0 2 , S-97

AN ORDINANCE CREATING ONE (1) REGULAR PLANTILLA POSITION OF SANITARY ENGINEER III (SALARY GRADE 19) UNDER THE SANITATION SERVICES DIVISION, CITY HEALTH DEPARTMENT, QUEZON CITY, AND PROVIDING FOR ITS SPECIFIC FUNCTIONS AND/OR DUTIES AND APPROPRIATE THE AMOUNT OF TWO HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED THIRTY PESOS AND SIXTY-EIGHT CENTAVOS (P239,430.68) TO COVER THE SALARIES, WAGES AND ALLOWANCES FOR THE SAID POSITION IN THE 1998 ANNUAL BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the Sanitation Services Division of the Quezon City Health Department is vested with a very vital and important task of issuing sanitary permits and implementing sanitary laws, ordinances, rules and regulations;

WHEREAS, it appears that the staffing pattern of the said Division does not have any position for a personnel who has been educated, trained, and an expert on the field of sanitary engineering;

WHEREAS, hiring of personnel who has been educated and trained in the field of sanitary engineering is very vital in order for the said Division to effectively perform its assigned task;

## NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. There is hereby created one (1) regular plantilla position of Sanitary Engineer III (Salary Grade 19) under the Sanitation Services Division, Quezon City Health Department.

SECTION 2. No person shall be appointed to the position created under the preceding section unless he or she is a holder of a Bachelor's degree in Sanitary Engineering and have passed the licensure examination for Sanitary Engineer being given by the Professional Regulation Commission (PRC).

SECTION 3. The personnel who shall be appointed to the position created under Section I hereof shall have the following specific functions and/or duties:

- a. shall provide the technical supervision in the locality, particularly on water supply sanitation, proper excrete disposal, refuse collection and disposal, and recommend abatement of sanitary misances;
- b. shall perform investigations and corrections of engineering works and projects that are hazardous to public health due to faulty designs, construction and operation or management;
- c. shall advise the City Health Officer, through the Chief of the Sanitation Division, on the implementation of public health engineering policies:
- d. shall survey technical reports and cost estimate of projects related to sanitary engineering;
- e. shall assist the City Health Officer in the formulation of plans, policies and guidelines on environmental sanitation program;
- f. shall act as adviser to the City Health Officer and higher authorities in matters pertaining to environmental health, particularly in the area of sanitation engineering;
- g. shall coordinate with the Department of Engineering and other related agencies to assure that the sanitation requirements are followed as required by law in terms of buildings and other construction for private and public use;
- h. the City Health Officer may provide for other duties and responsibilities attached with the said position which shall be primarily related to sanitary engineering.

SECTION 4. Subject to adjustment and/or increase as maybe provided for under the law, the amount of Two Hundred Thirty-Nine Thousand Four Hundred Thirty Pesos and Sixty-Eight Centavos (P239,430.68) is hereby appropriated to pay for annual salary, benefits and insurance premiums of the position created under Section 1 hereof, broken down as follows:

The said amount shall be regularly provided for in the Annual Budget of Quezon City. However, any amount that may be needed after the approval of this ordinance shall be funded through augmentation or by including the same in the Supplemental Budget.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
