ORDINANCE NO SP- 101, S-99

AN ORDINANCE RENAMING LA TRINIDAD STREET TO ENRIQUE SOBREPENA STREET.

Introduced by Councilors NANETTE CASTELO DAZA, JESUS C. SUNTAY, MARCEL C. RILLO, RAMON G. MATHAY, ALMA F. MONTILLA and BAYANI V. HIPOL.

Co-Introduce by Councilors Wilma Amoranto-Sarino, Antonio L. Sioson, Elizabeth A. Delarmente, Rommel R. Abesamis, Winston "Winnie" T. Castelo, Ma. Fresca M. Biglang-awa, Godofredo T. WHEREAS, Bishop Enrique C. Sobrepeña, was a nationalist, constitutionalist, educator and a hero of the war against Japan in the Bataan Campaign (1941-1942);

WHEREAS, Bishop Sobrepeña, a well known leader of the Philippine Protestant Community was a Pastor, an Evangelist, a moving force in the ecumenical movement and seeker of the Unity of the Christian Church;

WHEREAS, Bishop Sobrepeña Memorial Church and School has been serving the people of Barangay Damayang Lagi thru education and assistance in times of calamities;

WHEREAS, the Sanggunian Barangay of Barangay Damayang Lagi, in its Barangay Resolution No. 186, S-98, unanimously and favorably endorsed and recommended the renaming of La Trinidad Street to Enrique Sobrepeña Street in memory of Bishop Calica Sobrepeña Street;

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Bishop Sobrepeña Memorial Church headed by Justice Abraham F. Sarmiento, Chairman of the Board, through his letter dated October 26, 1998, requested the City Council, through the City Councilor of the Fourth District of Quezon City, to rename La Trinidad Street to Enrique C. Sobrepeña Street;

WHEREAS, in commemoration of his 100th year birth anniversary on March 7, 1999 and as a remembrance to his contribution to Philippine society, it is but fitting that the street where he lived for the last twenty years of his life be named after him;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991, Section 13, paragraph b (2), the Sanggunian of highly urbanized cities in consultations with the National Historical Institute (NHI) are authorized to change the name of city roads, avenues, boulevards, thoroughfares and bridges;

WHEREAS, the NHI interposes no objection to such change of street name;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:


SECTION 1. La Trinidad Street in Barangay Damayang Lagi, District IV, Quezon City, is hereby renamed to ENRIQUE C. SOBREPENA Street.

SECTION 2. To avoid any inconvenience that may arise in the delivery of postal matters and in guiding people accustomed to the old name, the signage of the new street name shall include "La Trinidad Street", to be printed at the bottom of the signage "Enrique C. Sobrepeña Street" for at least one (1) year.


SECTION 3. The City Council Secretary shall furnish a copy to the Office of the President, both Houses of Congress, National Statistics Office, Philippine Postal Corporation, National Historical Institute and other concerned agencies for their information and appropriate action.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
