AN ORDINANCE GRANTING FRANCHISES TO THE ONE HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE (145) PETITIONERS FOR THE OPERATION OF MOTORIZED TRICYCLE-FOR-HIRE WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF QUEZON CITY ON THEIR RESPECTIVE ROUTES.

WHEREAS, the Quezon City government considers the importance of an efficient and affordable transportation and communication as basic necessities which should always be made available to the riding public particularly in the interior or in remote areas of the City that would bring them to and from common or main thoroughfares within the limits of its jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, Filipino ingenuity utilizing the motorized tricycle as a means of public conveyance has been widely accepted/adopted by the general public;

WHEREAS, the City Council in the exercise of its inherent power enacts ordinances granting franchises and authorizing the issuance of permit or licenses and as such regulate the operation of tricycles and grant franchises for the operation thereof within the territorial jurisdiction of the City (Sec. 458 (3) (vi) R.A. 7160);

WHEREAS, a petition for issuance of franchises was filed, processed and pre-qualified, and recommended by the Tricycle Franchising Board to the City Council for the grant thereof pursuant to Ordinance No. SP-15, S-99 as amended, as contained in its Resolution No. 003, dated March 12, 1999 (QCTFB) copy thereof is herein appended and forming integral part hereof, after finding that petitioners have the qualification and the grant thereof will redound to the general interest and welfare of the community.

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. Franchises are hereby granted to the following One Hundred Forty-Five (145) petitioners, subject to existing laws, rules and regulations that are now and may hereafter be approved and promulgated with their respective indicated routes, body identification number, barangay and TODA affiliation, to wit:


SECTION 2. Individual Franchise Certificates shall be issued to the petitioners/franchisees named in Section 1 hereof upon the approval of this ordinance.
