ORDINANCE NO. ~~SP~~ - 822, S-99

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING NAMES TO STREETS, ROADS AND ALLEYS FOUND WITHIN AND TRAVERSING THE CITY HALL COMPLEX AND AUTHORIZING THE OFFICE OF THE CITY MAYOR, THRU THE CITY LIBRARIAN, TO MAKE CONSULTATION WITH THE PHILIPPINE HISTORICAL COMMISSION OF THE NAMES TO BE GIVEN AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, it has been noted that existing streets, roads and alleys found inside the perimeters and traversing within the City Hall Complex have no names, except for designation of building located therein;

WHEREAS, as a consequence thereof, transients and residents transacting business with or visiting the City government are confused and lost inside the City Hall Compound;

WHEREAS, RA 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, empowers every local government unit to regulate and manage all streets, roads, avenues, and boulevards under its jurisdiction and control, including the naming thereof;

WHEREAS, there is a necessity to identify the streets, roads and alleys within the City Hall Complex, for specific address to avoid lost and confusion;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. There is hereby provided names to the streets, roads and alleys within and traversing the City Hall Complex.


SECTION 2. The Office of the Mayor, thru the City Librarian shall make consultation with the Philippine Historical Commission of the names to be given in accordance with provision of the Local Government Code.

SECTION 3. The Office of the City Mayor, thru the Cultural and Tourism Affairs Office, City Engineer's Office and the City Librarian, shall jointly assist in the implementation of this Ordinance.



SECTION 4. Funds needed to implement this ordinance shall be taken from the calamity fund of the City Mayor, or any available funds of the City Treasury.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.


