ORDINANCE NO. SP. 870

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING SECURITY GUARDS AND OTHER SIMILAR PERSONS OR PERSONNEL OF SUBDIVISIONS OR VILLAGES IN QUEZON CITY FROM REQUIRING DRIVERS OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO DEPOSIT THEIR DRIVER'S LICENSES BEFORE THEY ARE ALLOWED ENTRY TO SAID SUBDIVISIONS OR VILLAGES AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. Security guards and other persons, unless deputized by the Land Transportation Office, manning the entrances or gates of subdivisions and villages in Quezon City are prohibited from requiring drivers of motor vehicles to deposit their driver's licenses before they are allowed entry to said subdivisions and villages.

SECTION 2. Violation of this Ordinance shall be penalized by a fine of One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) or by imprisonment of five (5) days or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court. The Homeowners Association Officials, together with the implementing person/s concerned, shall be answerable for the penalties herein provided for violation made at their orders or discretion.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after publication in a newspaper of general circulation in the city.
