ORDINANCE NO. SP- 980 -2000

AN ORDINANCE CREATING TEN (10) ADDITIONAL PERMANENT POSITIONS OF FINGERPRINT TECHNICIAN AIDES WITH SALARY GRADE FIVE (5) UNDER THE PERSONNEL AND DOCUMENT SECURITY SECTION, SECURITY DIVISION, DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC ORDER AND SAFETY AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE.

Introduced by Councilor ERIC Z. MEDINA.

WHEREAS, Section 458 (VIII) of the Local Government Code empowers the City council to:

xxx Determine the positions and the salaries, wages, allowances and other emoluments and benefits of officials and employees paid wholly or mainly from City funds and provide expenditures necessary for the proper conduct of programs, projects, services and activities of the city government. xxx

WHEREAS, one of the activities of the City government is the issuance of Police Clearance through the Central Police District Office (CPDO);

WHEREAS, the CPDO Office employs casual employees whose salaries are taken from the financial assistance funded by the Quezon City government;

WHEREAS, there are incumbents assisting the CPDO who have already rendered services as fingerprint aides for, more or less, twenty (20) years;

WHEREAS, the aforementioned personnel discharging their duties as fingerprint aides are apprehensive of their security of tenure for being casual employees for several years;

WHEREAS, the issuance of Police Clearance also derives revenues thus appropriations for financial assistance to the CPDO becomes justifiable;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. There is hereby created ten (10) additional permanent positions of Fingerprint Technician Aides with salary grade five (5) under the Personnel and Document Security Section, Security Division, Department of Public Order and Safety

SECTION 2. The incumbent Fingerprint Aides under the Central Police District Office who are assisting in the taking of fingerprints necessary in the issuance of police clearances shall be given preference in the appointment to the positions created in Section 1 hereof, PROVIDED that, they possess the qualification standards set by the Civil Service Commission.


SECTION 3. The amount necessary for the payment of salaries and other emoluments appurtenant to the positions created herein shall be taken and allocated from the appropriation of the above mentioned department in the 2001 Annual Budget and every year thereafter.


SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
