ORDINANCE NO. SP- 1049, S-2001

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING QUEZON CITY IN A CONTINUING STATE OF CALAMITY DUE TO LACK OF ADEQUATE DUMPING SITE AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR TO TAKE EMERGENCY MEASURES PARTICULARLY THE ACQUISITION OF LAND ADJACENT TO THE EXISTING DUMPING SITE AS TEMPORARY DUMPING SITE FOR THE EXCESS/ADDITIONAL WASTES BEING COLLECTED FROM VARIOUS DISTRICTS OF QUEZON CITY CHARGEABLE AGAINST THE CALAMITY FUND.

Introduced by Councilors GODOFREDO T. LIBAN II,
ELIZABETH A. DELARMENTE and JORGE L. BANAL.

WHEREAS, the entire Metro Manila area is in a state of crisis due to the inability of the Metro Manila Development Authority (MMDA) to identify an adequate dumping site for proper disposal of wastes collected in various cities/municipalities in Metro Manila;

WHEREAS, as an emergency measure the MMDA Chairman called for an emergency meeting of the MMDA Council to find a solution to the problem by allowing the Local Government Unit (LGU) to find a suitable landfill site/composting site and even drafting a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with LGU to the effect that the MMDA will replenish to LGU the costs of maintenance and operation of the temporary dumpsite/landfill of the LGU;

WHEREAS, the City Council, in its Resolution No. SP-1534, S-2001 has authorized the City Mayor to purchase two (2) parcels of land located in Payatas, Quezon City and technically described under TCT Nos. N-55202 and 55203, the price thereof to be determined by the City Appraisal Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. In view of the present garbage situation, the city is hereby declared in a state of calamity;

SECTION 2. The City Mayor is hereby authorized to take such emergency measure as may be necessary to solve the said garbage situation by negotiating and acquiring properties adjacent to the present dumping site to be used as temporary landfill area/additional dumpsite to accommodate excess/additional wastes collected from various districts, chargeable against the Calamity Fund.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance takes effect upon its approval.
