ORDINANCE NO. SP-1062, S-2001

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 5 OF ORDINANCE NO. SP-15, S-92, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. SP-351, S-95, ORDINANCE NO. SP-479, S-96, AND ORDINANCE NO. SP-787, S-99, SO AS TO STREAMLINE THE COMPOSITION OF THE QUEZON CITY TRICYCLE FRANCHISING BOARD.

WHEREAS, since its inception, the Quezon City Tricycle Franchising Board has undergone three (3) membership changes in a bid to make it more effective in regulating tricycle operation, the last time was on June 1, 1999 when all city councilors were made regular members thereof;

WHEREAS, apparently, under this set-up, the City Council has been constituted as a Committee of the whole where attendance of all the city councilors, or at least a majority of them, is required every time the Board meets to tackle matters concerning tricycle operation and later discuss the same issues again when presented for consideration by the City Council meeting in plenary session;

WHEREAS, this scenario is not only unwieldy, but is also taking so much precious time of the City Council which, otherwise, could be channeled to other worthwhile affairs of the city government;

WHEREAS, added to this problem is the systematic attitudinal transformation of the tricycle sector's representatives to the Quezon City Tricycle Franchising Board through a methodical scheme of promoting private rather than public interest;

WHEREAS, parenthetically, these problems have been counter productive to the prejudice of the interest of the commuting public; hence, the need to streamline the composition of the Quezon City Tricycle Franchising Board so that the purposes for which it was created could at least be approximated;

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NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED.

SECTION 1. Section 5 of Ordinance No. SP-15, S-92, as amended by Ordinance No. SP-351, S-95, Ordinance No. SP-479, S-96, and Ordinance No. SP-787, S-99, is hereby further amended to read as follows:


1. The Chairman of the Committee on Transportation and Communication, as Chairman;
2. The Chairman of the Committee on Barangay Affairs and Community Relation as member;
3. The Head of the Department of Public Order and Safety, as member;
4. The Head of the Office of the Tricycle Regulatory Unit, as member;
5. A representative from the non-governmental organizations duly accredited by the city government, as member, (to be determined by the Quezon City Council) and
6. A representative from the tricycle associations duly accredited by the City government, as member.


The representatives from the non-governmental and tricycle organizations shall be elected at large by the presidents of their respective associations and shall hold office for one (1) year reckoned from the time of their election which shall be set by the Board within a reasonable time after the effectivity of this Ordinance. They shall be entitled to a per diem of Seven Hundred Fifty Pesos (P750.00) each per meeting attended.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
