ORDINANCE NO. SP 1087, S-2001

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL ESTABLISHMENTS OPERATING WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF QUEZON CITY WHICH CHARGE PARKING FEES AS A REGISTERED BUSINESS TO HIRE GUARDS TO WATCH OVER THE MOTOR VEHICLES PARKED IN THEIR PREMISES.

WHEREAS, most establishments in Quezon City are now charging fees for the parking of motor vehicles within their premises;

WHEREAS, notwithstanding the payment of parking fees, these establishments have unilaterally declared that they are not liable for the loss of, or damage to, the motor vehicles while parked in their premises;

WHEREAS, it is only fair and just that these establishments should guard the motor vehicles parked in the pay parking area in exchange for the fees paid therefor.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:


SECTION 1. All establishments in Quezon City which charge parking fees as a registered business are hereby required to hire a minimum of one (1) guard for every fifty (50) parking lots to watch over the motor vehicles in the pay parking area.

SECTION 2. Any violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be penalized by imprisonment of not less than six (6) months, but not more than one (1) year at the discretion of the Court. The penalty provided for herein shall be imposed upon the owner and/or administrator of the establishments.


SECTION 3. The establishments covered by this ordinance shall put up the proper signage's to properly inform all clients of said establishments.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its publication in a newspaper of general circulation in the locality.


