ORDINANCE NO. SP-**1252**S-2003

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL IN BARANGAY TALIPAPA, QUEZON CITY, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Section 17, Article II of the 1987 Philippine Constitution expressly provides that "the State shall give priority to education x x x to foster patriotism and nationalism, accelerate social progress, and promote total human liberation and development;

WHEREAS, Section 1, Article XIV of the same Constitution further provides that "the State shall protect and promote the right of all citizens to quality education at all levels and shall take appropriate steps to make such education accessible to all;"

WHEREAS, at present there is no public high school in Barangay Talipapa, Quezon City;

WHEREAS, in order to make education accessible to all, especially to the students who are talented but poor, a public high school must be established in Barangay Talipapa to provide quality secondary education to the graduates of elementary schools therein.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. There is hereby established under the Division of City Schools of Quezon City a public high school to be known as the "TALIPAPA HIGH SCHOOL".


SECTION 2. The said public high school shall be erected and/or constructed in Barangay Talipapa, Quezon City, in a place to be determined by the Sangguniang Barangay in consultation with the Local School Board.

SECTION 3. The faculty and staffing requirements of the Public High School shall be prepared by the Superintendent of the Division of City School immediately upon approval of this ordinance and shall be submitted to the City Council for confirmation to form an integral part of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. The initial funds necessary for the construction, maintenance, and operation of the said public high school, as determined by the Local School Board, shall be taken from the Special Education Funds of Quezon City or from any available funds of the City Treasury. Thereafter, the amount necessary for its actual operation shall be included in the annual appropriations of the City government.


SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
