ORDINANCE NO SP- **1451**, S-2004

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE BARANGAY COUNCIL OF COMMONWEALTH TO CONDUCT THE NUMBERING OF RESIDENTIAL, COMMERCIAL AND OTHER BUILDINGS WITHIN ITS TERRITORIAL LIMITS AND OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City Council is empowered to regulate the numbering of residential, commercial and other buildings within its territorial boundaries pursuant to Section 458 (a) (2) (xiv) of Republic Act 7160;

WHEREAS, there is a necessity to conduct numbering of residential, commercial and other buildings at Barangay Commonwealth as could be implied in the "whereases" of Barangay Council Resolution No. 05, S-04, adopted January 26, 2004, thus;

"Whereas, the Barangay Council as part of its Community Development Project has decided to undertake the numbering of houses, building and establishment to boost and help speed-up mail delivery operation and other related purposes."

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. The Barangay Council of Barangay Commonwealth is hereby authorized to conduct numbering of residential, commercial and other buildings within its territorial limit.


SECTION 2. The Council may impose reasonable charge to cover the expenditures in any amount not more than One Hundred Pesos (P100.00) per house, structure or building.

SECTION 3. The Office of the City Engineer and the City Planning and Development Office shall assist the Barangay Council in the implementation of this ordinance.


SECTION 4. The Barangay Council, the Office of the City Engineer and the City Planning and Development Office shall submit a joint-report to the City Council on the result of the numbering within 60 days after its approval.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.


