ORDINANCE NO. SP-453, S-2003

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL CINEMA OWNERS AND OPERATORS IN QUEZON CITY TO INCREASE THE PRICES OF THEIR ADMISSION TICKETS BY ONE PESO (P1.00) COVERING THE PERIOD FROM JANUARY 1 TO 31, 2005, TO SUPPORT THE PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES OF THE NATIONAL ARCHERY ASSOCIATION OF THE PHILIPPINES (NAAP).

WHEREAS, the Philippines will be hosting the Southeast Asian Games (SEAG) from November 30 to December 8, 2005;

WHEREAS, the said event shall provide not only immense exposure for Filipino athletes to international competition, but also serve as a booster for the Philippines' tourism industry;

WHEREAS, in preparation to the Southeast Asian Games, the National Archery Association of the Philippines (NAAP) is embarking on a fund raising campaign to support the national athletes, particularly Ms. Jasmin L. Figueroa, the lone Filipino Archer, who defeated the three-time world champion from Italy in the recently concluded Athens Olympics;

WHEREAS, in a letter dated 28 September 2004 of Ms. Leonora Fe S. Brawner, Ed. D., President, National Archery Association of the Philippines, the Quezon City Council has been requested to enact an ordinance requiring all cinema owners and operators in Quezon City to increase their theater admission fees by One Peso (P1.00) covering the period from January 1 to 31, 2005, a copy thereof is attached as Annex "A";

NOW THEREFORE,


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. All cinema owners and operators in Quezon City are hereby required to increase their theater admission fees by One Peso (P1.00) covering the period from January 1 to 31, 2005.

SECTION 2. All proceeds of this fund raising shall be used solely to finance the programs and activities of the National Archery Association of the Philippines and a corresponding financial report shall be submitted to the City Council for its information.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.
