ORDINANCE NO. SP- 1514, S-2005

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING HONORABLE FELICIANO R. BELMONTE, JR., TO PURCHASE THE BOOK ENTITLED "HOW TO PREVENT FIRE" (SAFETY MEASURE AND PRECAUTIONS) AND TO DISTRIBUTE THE SAME TO ALL BARANGAYS WITHIN QUEZON CITY THROUGH THE BARANGAY CAPTAINS AND APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF TWO MILLION PESOS (P2,000,000.00) OR SO MUCH THEREOF AS MAY BE NECESSARY.

WHEREAS, it is a public knowledge that fire and conflagration occurred unexpectedly, often caused by negligence and faulty wiring from among other things;

WHEREAS, so much lives and properties have been wasted by reason of the occurrence of fire and conflagrations in residential as well as commercial areas, despite the requirements imposed by regulatory laws to install firefighting equipment;

WHEREAS, the chances of fire breakout will be minimized if residents/constituents of Quezon City will be better educated to prevent fire;

WHEREAS, the handbook - "How to Prevent Fire" - is a knowledgeable book to prevent the occurrence of fire and conflagrations;

WHEREAS, the City Council is empowered to enact wholesome laws to promote health and safety of its constituents.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. The City Mayor is authorized to purchase Handbook - "How to Prevent Fire" for distributions to the various Barangays of Quezon City.


SECTION 2. The quantity of the Handbook to be purchased shall correspond to the number of puroks or corresponding to populations of each barangays within the jurisdiction of Quezon City.

SECTION 3. Distribution scheme shall be based on the recommendation of the Barangay Operations Center;




