AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY SEVEN THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE PESOS AND THIRTY-SIX CENTAVOS (P1,457,425.36) FOR THE COMPLETION OF A TWO STOREY POLICE STATION ALONG P. TUAZON, BARANGAY MARILAG, QUEZON CITY WHOSE AMOUNT SHALL BE TAKEN FROM THE 2005 ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF QUEZON CITY.

Belmonte, Jr., City Mayor, this City through this humble representation the construction of a two storey police station along P. Tuazon, Barangay Marilag, Quezon City to coincide with the crime prevention program not only of the barangay concerned but also of the City government of Quezon City;

WHEREAS, there is an urgent need for the said construction in order to enhance police visibility not only within the area but as well as the entire Quezon City..

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. The amount of One Million Four Hundred Fifty Seven Thousand Four Hundred Twenty Five Pesos and Thirty Six Centavos (P1,457,425.36) is hereby appropriated for the completion of the two storey Police Station along P. Tuazon, Barangay Marilag, Quezon City which shall be taken from the 2005 Annual Budget of the Quezon City government.

SECTION 2. The Engineering Department shall take charge in the engineering and technical requirements of the completion.




