AN ORDINANCE DECLARING NOVEMBER 25 AS THE FOUNDING DATE OF THE QUEZON CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT AND TO COMMEMORATE THE SAME STARTING NOVEMBER 25, 2005 AND EVERY YEAR THEREAFTER.

WHEREAS, on November 1939 the first City Mayor of Quezon City exercised his function and organized the City government in accordance with its charter;

WHEREAS, in consonance to the organization of the Quezon City government were the appointment of its key officials including the Chief of Police of the Quezon City Police Department;

WHEREAS, on November 25, 1939 the first appointed Chief of Police of Quezon City organized the Quezon City Police Department;

WHEREAS, November 25 is an important date in the annals of the Quezon City Police Department which date should be reckoned with as its founding date, thus this ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:


SECTION 1. It is hereby declared November 25 as the founding date of the Quezon City Police Department. As such, on November 25, 2005, it will be deemed the 66<sup>th</sup> founding anniversary and shall be observed every year thereafter.

SECTION 2. The Office of the City Mayor through its designated officials and representative of the Quezon City Police Department shall formulate policy guidelines to achieve success in the yearly commemoration.

SECTION 3. The present and succeeding Chief of Police of the Quezon City Police Department in coordination with the Quezon City government shall take charge in the implementation of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.


