ORDINANCE NO. SP-1681, S-2006
(PO2005-279)

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL CINEMA OWNERS AND OPERATORS IN QUEZON CITY TO INCREASE THE PRICES OF THEIR ADMISSION TICKETS BY ONE PESO (P1.00) COVERING THE PERIOD FROM AUGUST 1 TO 30, 2006 TO SUPPORT THE PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES OF THE BOY SCOUTS OF THE PHILIPPINES (BSP), QUEZON CITY COUNCIL.

Introduced by Councilors ERIC Z. MEDINA, RESTITUTO B. MALANGEN, RAMON P. MADALLA, JORGE B. BANAL JR., ELIZABETH A. DELARMENTE, BAYANI V. HIPOLO, WINSTON "Winnie" T. CASTELO, and WENCEROM BENEDICT C. LAGUMBAY.

WHEREAS, the Boy Scouts of the Philippines (BSP), Quezon City Chapter, will have a series of activities in conjunction with the annual celebration of "Scouting Month";

WHEREAS, the programs and activities of the BSP will not only promote camaraderie but will highlight the importance of scouting in Philippine setting;

WHEREAS, due to the limited funds of the local chapter, the BSP will need help of the private sector to pursue and carry out its programs and activities.

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. All cinema owners and operators in Quezon City are hereby required to increase their theater fees by One Peso (P1.00) covering the period from August 1 to 30, 2006.


