AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL CINEMA OWNERS AND OPERATORS IN QUEZON CITY TO INCREASE THE PRICES OF THEIR ADMISSION TICKETS BY ONE PESO (P1.00) COVERING THE PERIOD FROM OCTOBER 1 TO 31, 2006 TO SUPPORT THE PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES OF THE FOUNDATION FOR RETIRED QUEZON CITY'S PRIDE, INC. (ASSOCIATION OF RETIRED POLICEMEN OF QUEZON CITY POLICE DISTRICT).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. All cinema owners and operators in Quezon City are hereby required to increase their theater fees by One Peso (P1.00) covering the period from October 1 to 31, 2006.


