ORDINANCE NO. **SR-1793**S-2007
(PO2007-77/PO2000-78)

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET NO. 1-GENERAL FUND BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2007 IN THE SUM OF TWENTY MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED EIGHTY THREE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED PESOS (P20,783,800.00) FOR ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR THE FORTHCOMING BARANGAY AND SK ELECTION ON OCTOBER 29, 2007.

Introduced by Councilors AIKO S. MELENDEZ, ANTONIO E. INTON, JR. and JESUS MANUEL C. SUNTAY.

WHEREAS, Section 50 of Batas Pambansa Bilang 881, otherwise known as the Omnibus Election Code of the Philippine provided that the "Local government shall appropriate such fund to defray such necessary and reasonable expenses of the members of the board of election tellers, board of canvasser, and the printing of election forms and procurement of other election paraphernalia and the installation of polling booths;

WHEREAS, initially, Twenty Million Seven Hundred Eighty Three Thousand Eight Hundred Pesos (P20,783,800.00) will be required to implement the aforesaid programs and must accordingly be appropriated by way of a Supplemental Budget;

WHEREAS, it is thus necessary to pass Supplemental Budget No. 1 to appropriate Twenty Million Seven Hundred Eighty Three Thousand Eight Hundred Pesos (P20,783,800.00) for the aforesaid purposed;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 458 (25) (i) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local government Code of 1991 states that it is the power of the Sangguniang Panlungsod to approve the annual and supplemental budgets of the city government and appropriate funds for specific programs, projects, services and activities of the city, or for other purpose not contrary to law, in order to promote the general welfare of the city and its inhabitants;

WHEREAS, there is a need to adopt this supplemental budget to defray the projected expenses for the 2007 Barangay and Sangguniang Kabataan elections on 29 October 2007 for the acquisition of supplies and materials;

WHEREAS, the Honorable Feliciano R. Belmonte, Jr., City Mayor, duly certified to the urgency of this Supplemental Budget No. 1.

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF QUEZON CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated the amount of Twenty Million Seven Hundred Eighty Three Thousand Eight Hundred Pesos (P20,783,800.00) Philippine Currency, by way of Supplemental Budget No. 1, to the 2007 General Fund Budget to finance the additional funding for the forthcoming Barangay and SK Election on October 29, 2007;


SECTION 2. The copy of the budget document containing the specific items of expenditure shall form an integral part of this Ordinance;

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.


